Notes:

- 1. SO\$ Membership First 2 tows, up to a maximum of \$500, within that membership year are free. Any subsequent tows, or once the maximum of \$500 has been reached, in that membership year, are charged at the cost of the fuel (based on the bowser price at the time of the activation), with a minimum of fee of \$50.
- 2 Ordinary Membership Any tows, in that membership year, are charged at the cost of the fuel (based on the bowser price at the time of the activation), with a minimum fee of \$50.
- 3 Visitor Membership valid for a period of one month. One tow, up to a maximum of \$200, within that one month period is free. Any subsequent tows, or once the maximum of \$200 has been reached, in that month, are charged at the cost of the fuel (based on the bowser price at the time of the activation), with a minimum fee of \$50.
- 4 All tows under the SO\$ option are limited to the MRHB area shown on the brochure inside your welcome kit. i.e. the member pays for any towage outside the prescribed area (at the discretion of MRHB skipper/commodore).
- 5 A Non Member, that requires a tow is required to pay twice the cost of the fuel (based on the bowser price at the time of the activation), with a minimum fee of \$100.

Other Membership Notes:

- 1. For members who joined prior to March 2016, the MRHB membership year runs from 1 April to 31 March each year. For members who joined after 1 April 2016, the membership year runs from the date of joining, for a period of 12 months.
- 2. If a membership is not renewed by the end of the current membership year, the member is deemed to be unfinancial for any activation, and the costs for a Non Member will apply.
- 3. MRHB will undertake the following for vessels that have broken down:
 - a. Tow the vessel back
 - b. Take a maximum of 100 litres of fuel out to the vessel (at the MRHB skipper's discretion)
 - c. Undertake a jump start for flat batteries
- 4. There are no reciprocal rights with any other VMR or Coastguard squadron.
- 5. A vessel requiring a tow may be taken back to any boat ramp or marina berth, within the MRHB area.
- 6. The S0\$ option is applicable only to recreational vessels used for private purposes and excludes vessels used commercially.
- 7. MRHB will normally not be involved with any retrieval involving a vessel only a situation classed as salvage. This may include a vessel which has run aground, has sunk or is drifting due to the anchor not holding or floating off a beach. The fundamental goal is to rescue people in distress.
- 8. Any activation for a tow etc. is subject to weather conditions and safety of the MRHB vessel, skipper and crew. The MRHB skipper has the option to abort the activation at any time they deem the situation to be unsafe or unduly dangerous.
